The team worked throughout Wednesday 3rd and Thursday 4th April as the pictures show the work progressing, doors were re-squared, re-strengthened and re-hinged. We have been advised the material used on the cover will keep us 2 degrees warmer in winter and a few degrees cooler in summer and it is anticipated that we will proceed with a water capture system to become as eco-friendly as possible
